## NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

October 9–15, 2016

**WHEREAS**, The City of Mukilteo is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our City; and

**WHEREAS**, Fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are where people are at greatest risk to fire; and

**WHEREAS**, The Mukilteo Fire Department is dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

**WHEREAS**, Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in home fires in half; and

**WHEREAS**, Mukilteo residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

**WHEREAS**, The 2016 Fire Prevention Week theme, “Don’t Wait—Check the Date! Replace Smoke Alarms Every 10 Years” reminds us to make sure residents know how old their smoke alarms are, and replace them at least every 10 years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that I, Jennifer Gregerson, Mayor of Mukilteo, do hereby proclaim October 9–15, 2016 as *Fire Prevention Week* throughout the City, and urge all people in Mukilteo to focus on smoke alarm replacement to keep their loved ones safe.
