Meeting Objective:

1. Council Member Lord was appointed Chair of the Infrastructure Committee.
2. The Infrastructure Committee reviewed the Transportation Committee's 2015 accomplishments and accession plan. The Infrastructure Committee agreed to work on the former Transportation Committee's on-going efforts and future goal.

Committee On-going Efforts:

1. Drive the creation/alignment or realignment of a roadmap and 5 year plan for transportation capital activities to the City's comprehensive plan
2. Review and make recommendations on the "Active Transportation" Plan and tie Plan to 6 year Transportation Improvement Plan
3. Define revenue streams to bolster pavement preservation program and multimodal infrastructure

Future Goals:

1. Tie PCI data to City's GIS as part of pavement preservation decision making process
3. The Committee also agreed to work on the following issues that were discussed at the Council's retreat held in January 2016.

"Develop policy recommendations for a sustainable transportation system"

Council Retreat discussion items:

- a. *Increased support for residents*
- b. *More responsive signage opportunities as a deterrent (also enforcement)*
- c. *Responsiveness of the program to citizen concerns (metrics)*

Speedway traffic/congestion

Pavement preservation plan

Explore street trees as one part of pavement preservation

BTW alternatives

- d. *Walking and bike trails*
- e. *Prioritize sidewalk*
- f. *Cross walks*

- a. ADA Transition for public right-of-way
- b. Capital Improvement Plan for Facilities
- c. Identify funding resources for City street preservation
- d. Identify and prioritize infrastructure improvement projects
