Police Department Update prepared by Chief Caldwell

April 30, 2015 meeting (moved from May 7)

PROJECTS:

- **Downtown Parking program – base installations are nearly complete. Toured the sites today. PW Crew is actively painting and striping LHP lot.**
- **SWAT: ILA and Agenda Bill June 1**
- **New World Systems training in full swing. Three 6-hour classes for all Patrol staff, 40 hour training for everyone else.**
- **Violent Offender’s Task Force with US Marshall’s ILA and Agenda Bill coming June 1**
- **ESCA: status update done by MSD Phillips. Project still moving forward to eventual move to DEM. Contracts being developed by North and South county agencies.**
- **Microchipping program with Animal Control under development. This program will provide free chips for residents. If animals are more easily tracked, this potential expedites reunification and lowers shelter costs.**
- **Electronic Home Detention update and jail savings. Document attached.**
- **Everett CC Criminal Justice has invited Chief Caldwell to join their advisory board. To begin this May.**

PERSONNEL:

- **Community Services Officer – Ranger job testing step one completed last week. Final Chief’s interviews Monday.**
- **Working with Civil Service to update hiring lists**
