- No more than 1 yard of materials (approximately 5 bags) and weighing not more than 65 pounds total; AND
- Up to <u>two</u> larger items such as mattresses, sofas, and large chairs
 Items for pickup must be bundled, boxed, or bagged by 7:00am September 17th and placed at curbside

by 7:00am September 17th and placed at curbside where your regular trash containers go. Large items must be placed at a public street where large trucks can easily pick the items up.


