

Items for pickup must be bundled, boxed, or bagged by 6:00am on May 20th and placed at curbside where your regular trash containers go. Large items must be placed at a public street where large trucks can easily pick the items up. It is recommended that you set items out the night before to ensure they are ready for pickup.

## **ITEMS ACCEPTED**

- No more than 1 yard of materials (approximately 5 bags) and weighing not more than 65 pounds total; AND
- Up to two larger items such as mattresses, sofas, large chairs, & lawnmowers that do NOT have gas or oil left in them

Paints, solvents, pesticides, gasoline, cleaning materials, tires, rocks, concrete, construction debris, sod, yard waste, TVs, computers, phones, or electronics
