



Mukilteo City Hall Rules

Welcome to Mukilteo City Hall.

City Hall is a public space that serves our community. To ensure a safe, respectful, and functional environment for all visitors and staff, the following rules apply to the entire City Hall, including the building, parking lot, and surrounding grounds. Persons who violate these rules may be asked to leave City Hall. If they return, they may be subject to prosecution per Chapter 9.24 of the Mukilteo Municipal Code.

Be Safe

- Observe posted hours of operation.
- Stay in public areas. Staff offices and service enclosures are off-limits.
- Leave your pets at home (service animals exempt).
- No open display of firearms or weapons (RCW 9.41.305).
- Do not smoke or vape on city property.
- No blocking anyone's ability to enter, leave, or move about.
- Personal items must be attended at all times; unattended items may be removed.

Be Respectful

- No amplified sound indoors.
- No posting of flyers or materials without prior approval.
- Disruptive, harassing, threatening, or violent behavior is not allowed.
- Photography, filming, and audio recording are permitted only in public areas and must not interfere with City operations or the privacy of others.
