International Overdose Awareness Day August 31, 2024

WHEREAS, International Overdose Awareness Day is the world's largest annual campaign to end overdose, remember those who have died, and acknowledge the grief of the family and friends left behind; and

WHEREAS, Mukilteo families have been affected by addiction and overdose, including five lives saved in 2023 by administering the overdose antidote Narcan (Naloxone), and we recognize our first responders, medical professionals, grassroots organizations, and others on the frontlines saving lives every day; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, drug overdose deaths were at 107,543 in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Overdose Awareness Day acknowledges the grief felt by families and friends who have been impacted, and this day provides an opportunity for people to openly mourn for loved ones without feeling guilt or shame; and

WHEREAS, this day seeks to send a strong message to current and former substance users that they are supported, deserving of dignity and respect, and worthy of recovery; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mukilteo remains committed to raising awareness and educating our community about addiction and overdose prevention.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Joe Marine, Mayor of the City of Mukilteo, hereby recognize the local impact of addiction and overdose deaths, and proclaim August 31, 2024, as *Overdose Awareness Day* in Mukilteo. I encourage all residents to help create a culture of compassion and have meaningful conversations to spread awareness and knowledge about addiction and overdose prevention.
