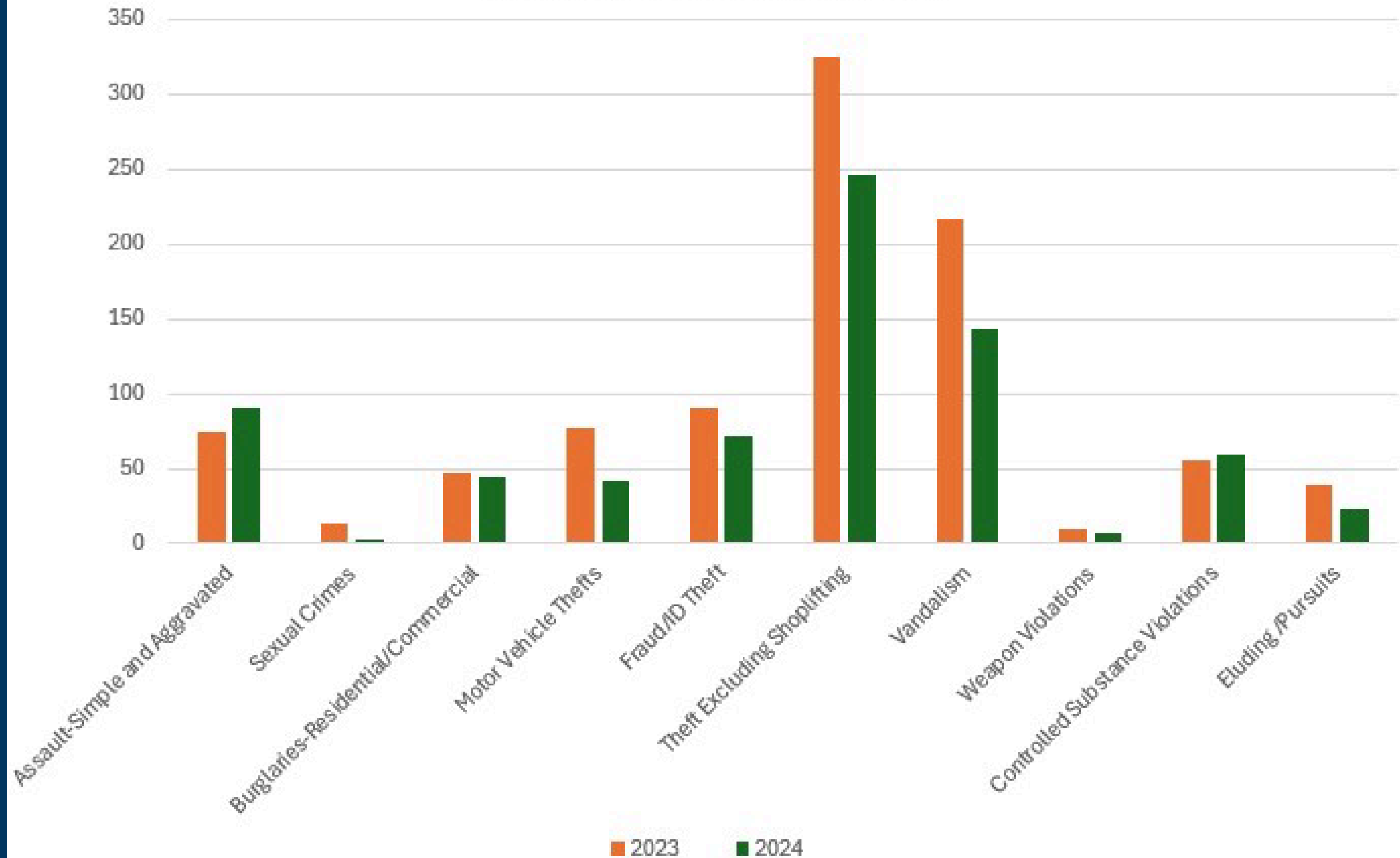

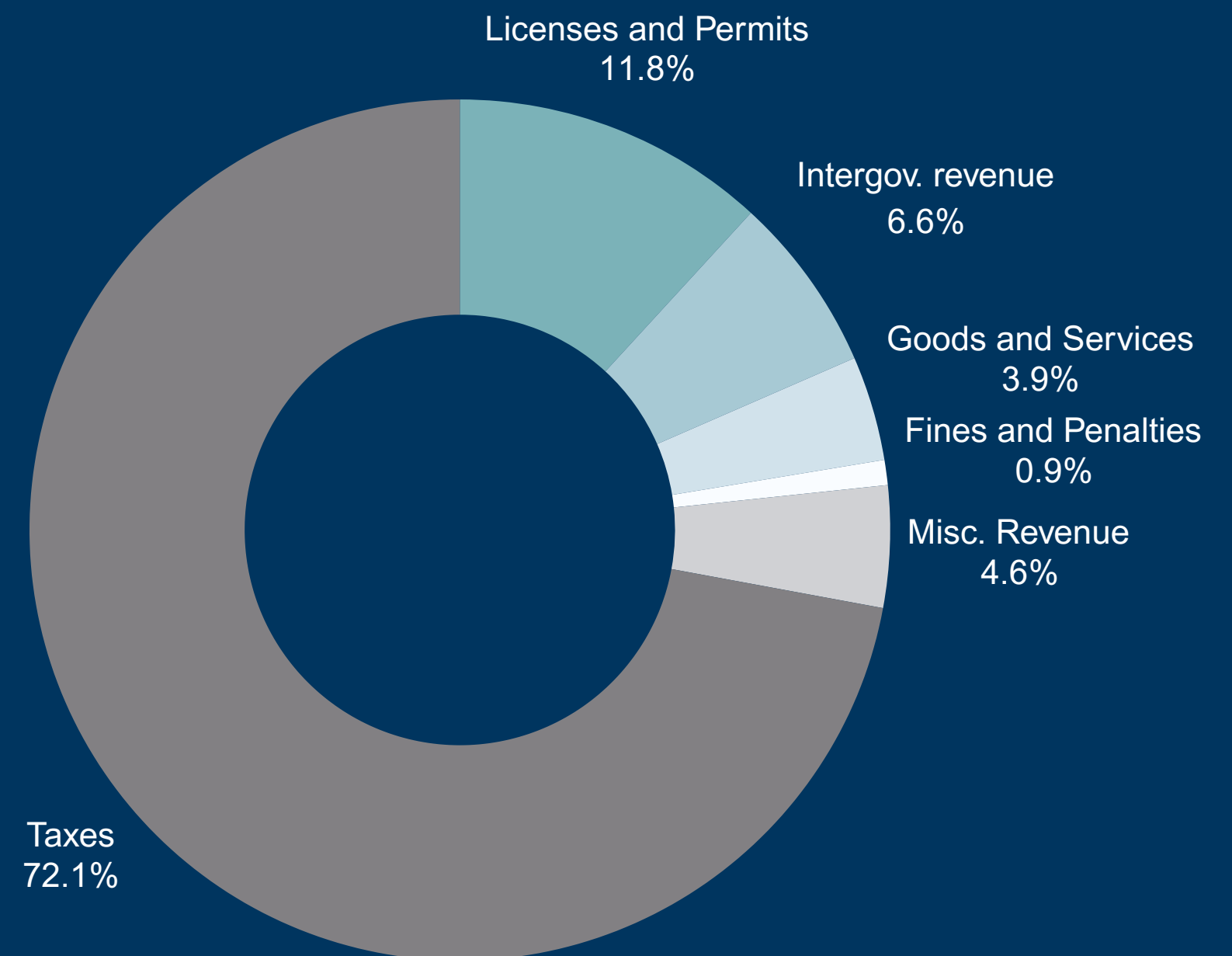

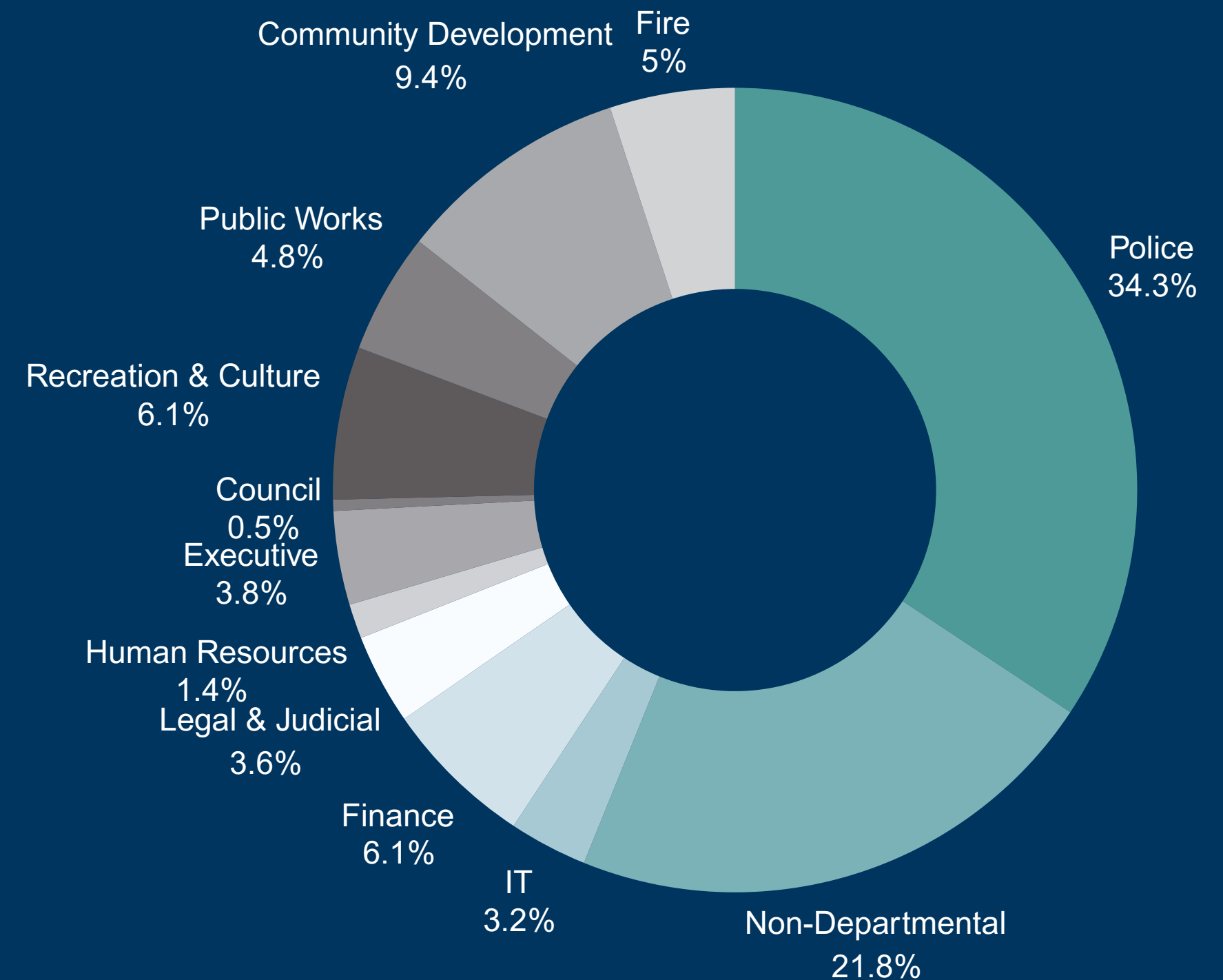

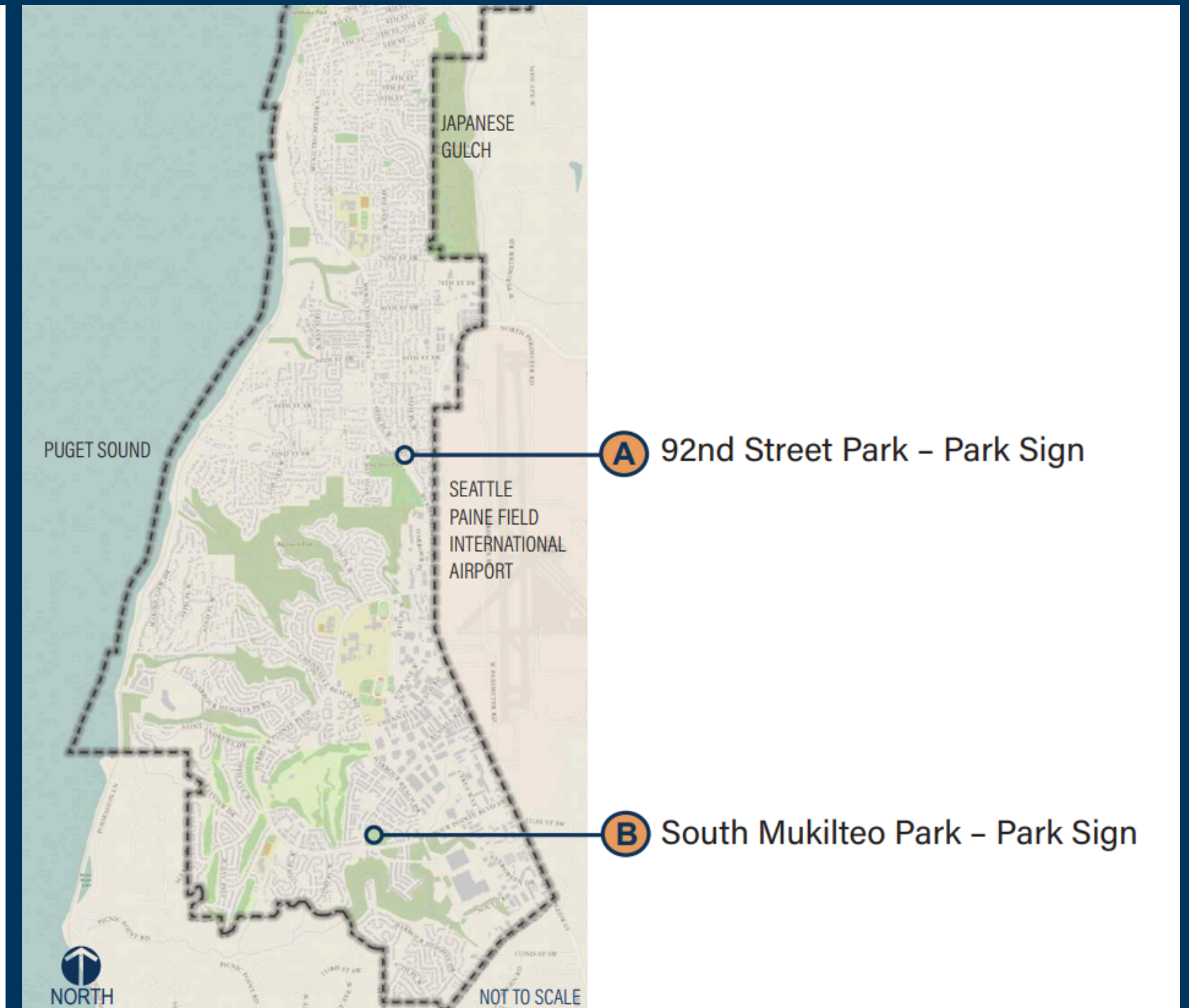
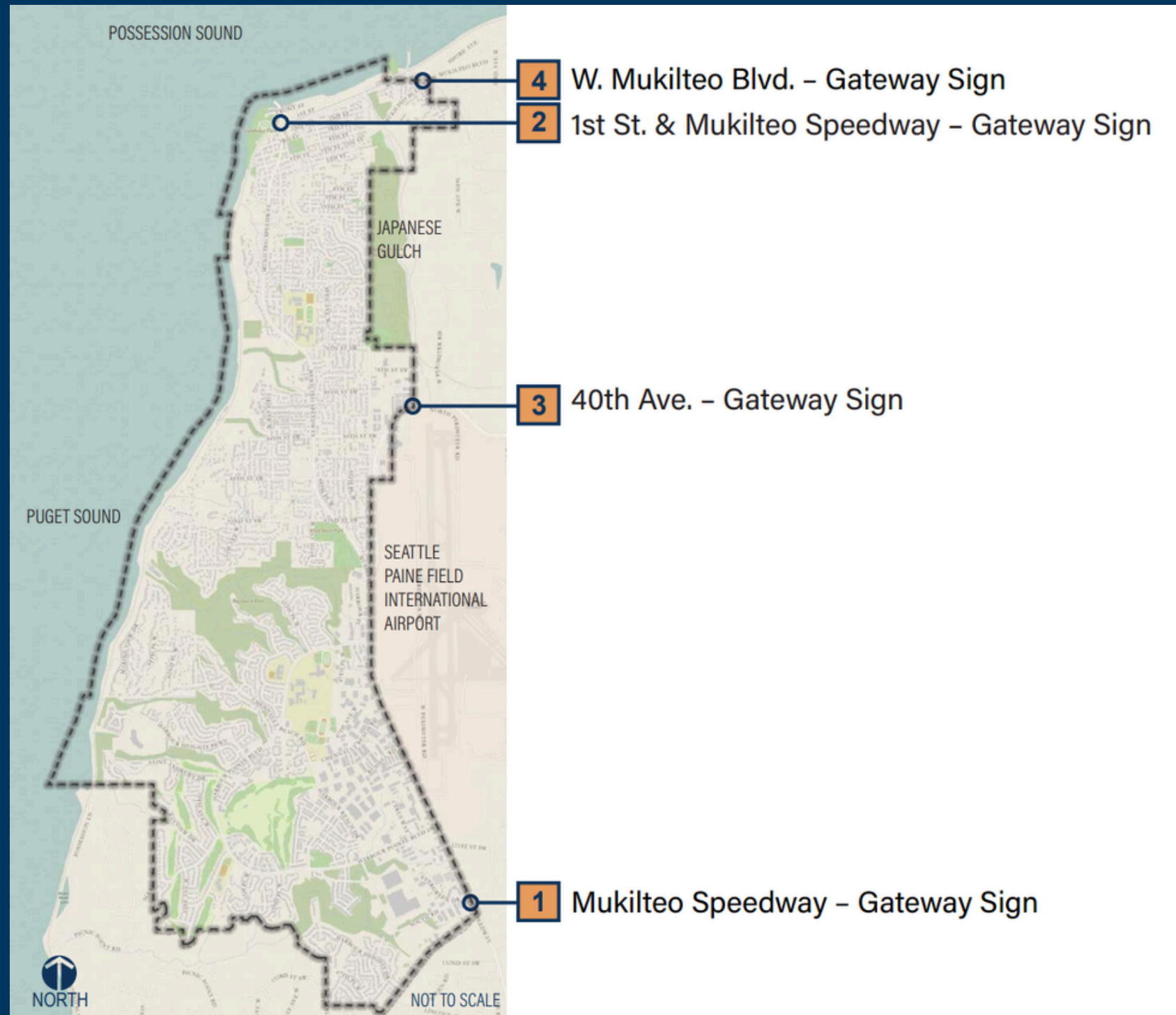


Existing Gateway and Park Signs

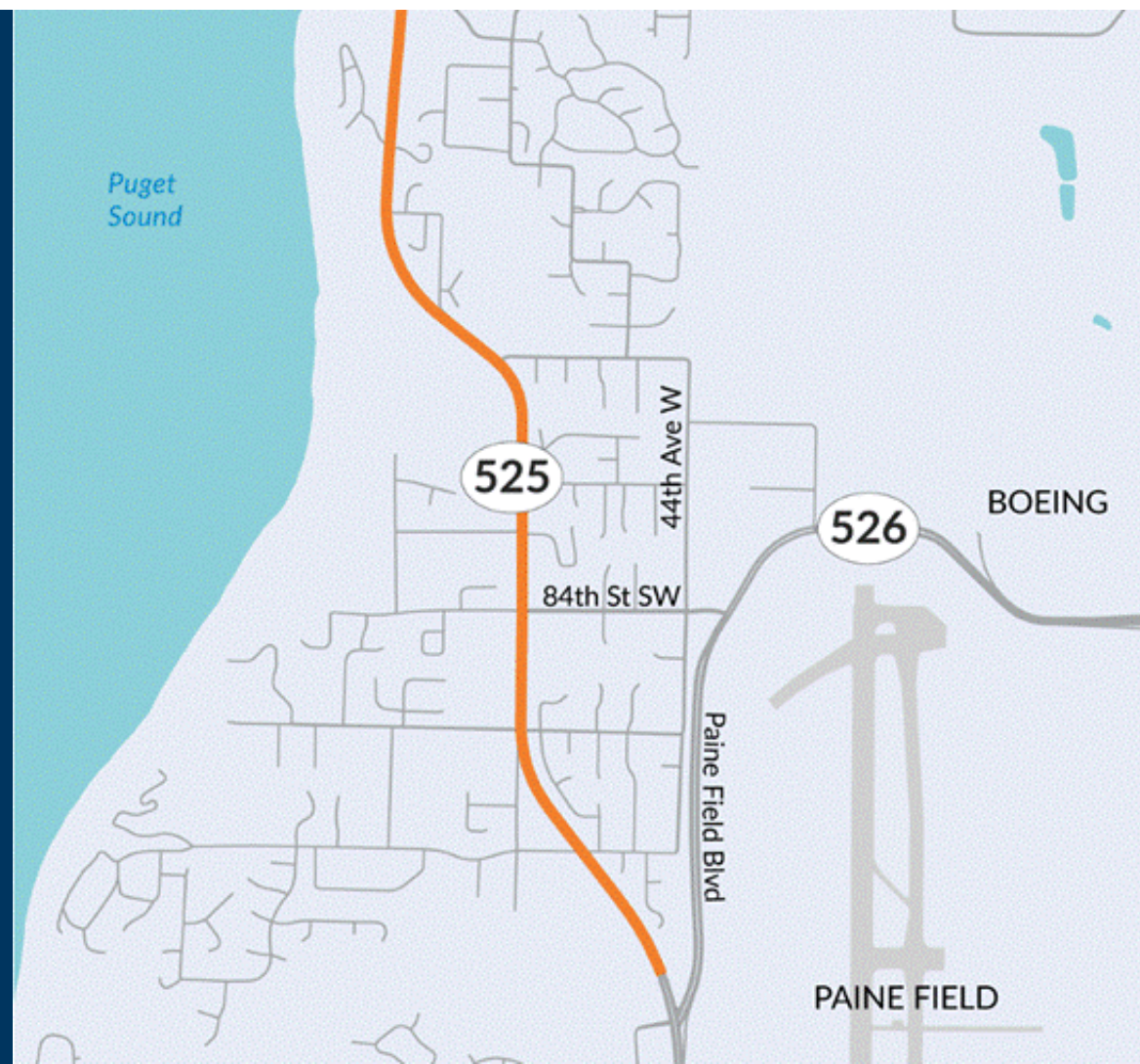

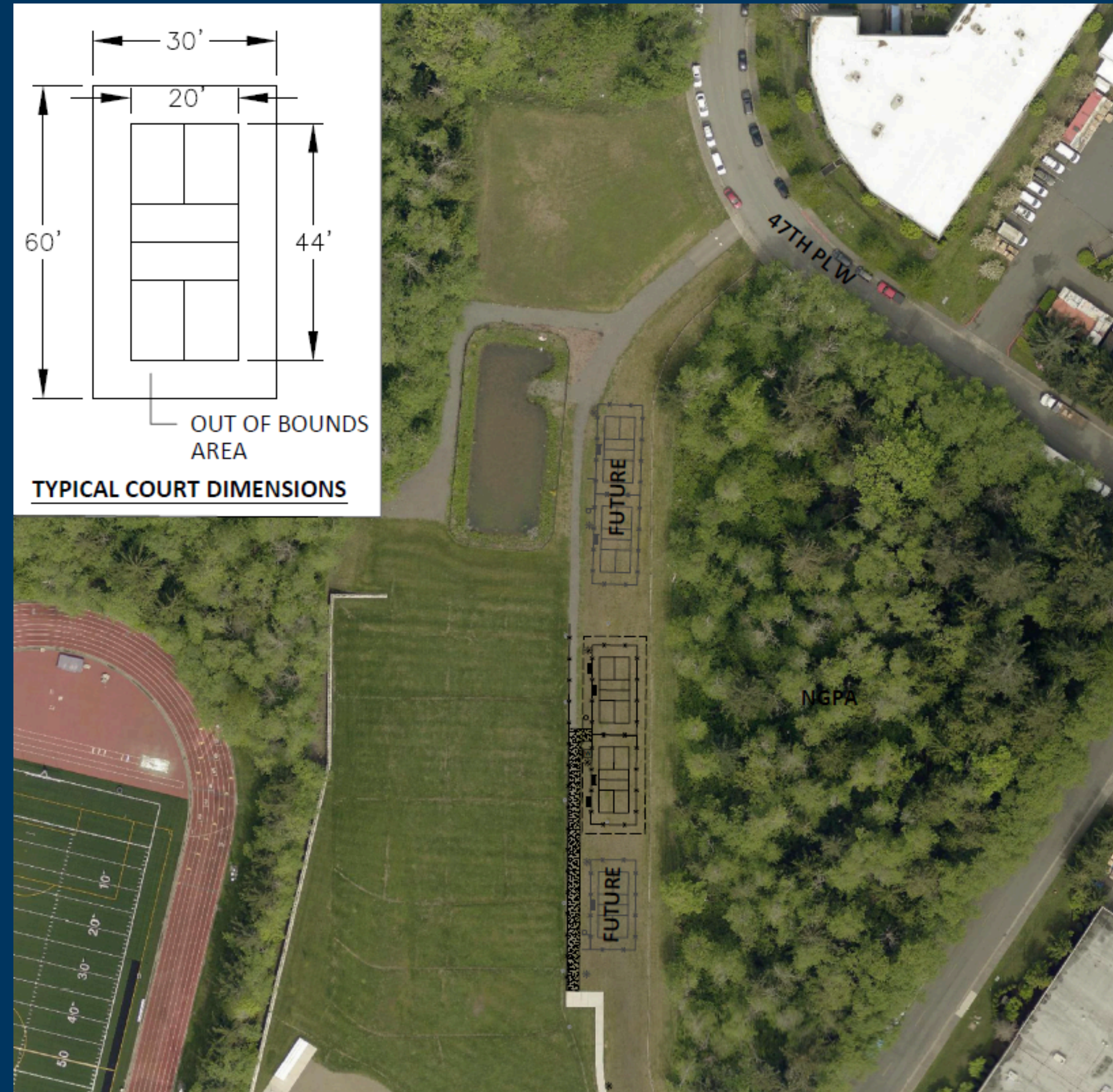
