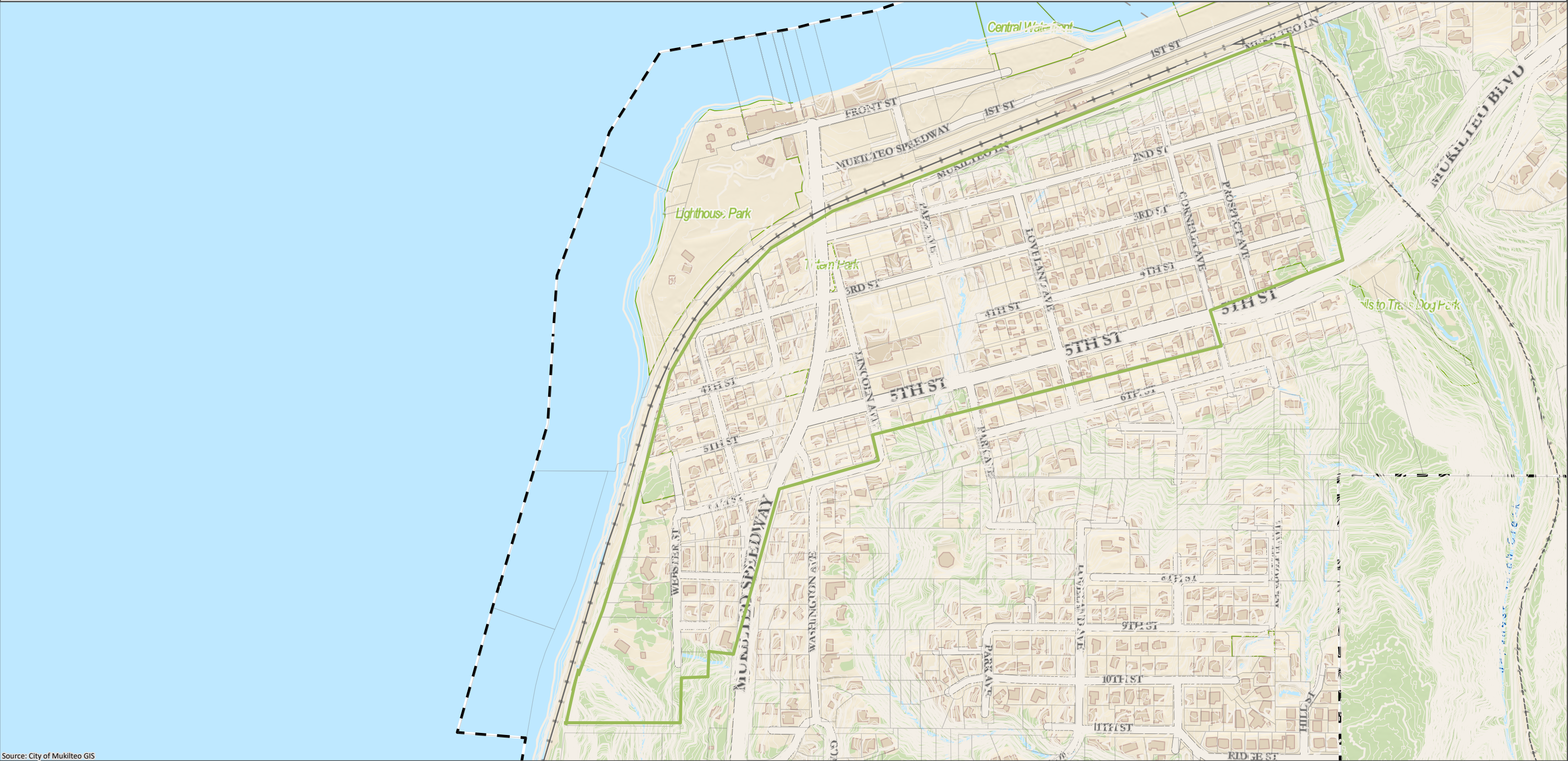
CALL TO ORDER	Chairperson Carlson called the meeting to order at 6:32 PM and led the flag salute.

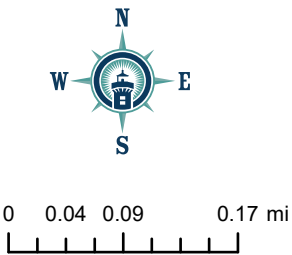
