1) 6-Year Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) Update

Staff presented a draft 6-Year TIP update to the Committee.

The Committee reviewed the draft 6-Year TIP and recommended two modifications. The first modification was a recommendation to remove the Bernie Webber Drive Park and Ride project from the TIP. The second modification was to add the Cyrus Way South Improvements (Harbour Pointe Boulevard to Evergreen Drive/SR 525) to the 2018 to 2023 TIP. The Committee recommended Council approval of the modified 6-Year TIP at the June 5, 2017 Council meeting.

2) 5th Street Preservation National Highway Performance Program Grant Application.

Staff presented the proposed 5th Street Preservation grant application.

The Committee unanimously recommended Council approval of the 5th Street Preservation grant application on May 15, 2017.

3) 2nd Street & Prospect Avenue Speed Bumps

Staff provided the Committee with a draft letter to impacted citizens outlining that temporary speed bumps installed in 2013 on 2^{nd} Street and Prospect Avenue would be removed as a result of the Traffic Calming Program (TCP) implemented in 2015. The TPC provides a process for citizens who have concerns regarding traffic calming

to work with the City to implement data driven solutions. The speed bumps were a temporary installation that predated the program.

The Committee recommended that Staff make revisions to the letter to extend the implementation of the temporary speed bump removal to a six month timeframe to give affected citizens an opportunity to engage in the TCP process.
