## **Meeting Objective:**

- 1. Review the Transportation Committee 2015 Accomplishments and Transportation Committee Accession Plan
  - a. The draft 2015 Annual/End of Year Committee Update was reviewed and approved by the Transportation Committee and finalized.
- 2. The following Grant opportunities:
  - Safe Routes to School, opened January 18<sup>th</sup>, and closes May 6<sup>th</sup>
  - Pedestrian and Bike Paths, opened January 18<sup>th</sup> and closes May 6<sup>th</sup>
  - Surface Transportation (Maintenance), opens March 14<sup>th</sup> and closes April 11<sup>th</sup>
  - CMAQ, opens March 14<sup>th</sup> and closes April 14<sup>th</sup>
  - a. Candidate projects for these grants are the 526 Shared Use Path and Pavement Preservation for 88th Street
- 3. Harbour Reach Drive extension concepts/cost estimate was reviewed. Due to budgetary constraints the intersection at Cyrus Way and HPB will stay a signal. The intersection at HRD and HPB will be redeveloped as a single lane roundabout. Eight different cross-sections were reviewed by the committee. The Committee favored the two lanes with standard bike lanes/landscape

strip/sidewalks. The Committee did recommend that the Cascade Cycle group be consulted about what type of cycling facility was preferred.

This was the last meeting of the Transportation Committee. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
