 - iii. Went through some plans of what and who we can feature in podcasts.
 - iv. Assigned roles:
 - 1. Graphics team:
 - a. create podcast cover image and maybe use wavve.co
 - 2. Outreach team:
 - a. download streak maybe
 - b. create email template. Include an overview/mission statement of the Podcast when sending out email.
 - c. find 4 essential workers
 - 3. Podcast editing team: get Audacity and get used to it
 - 4. Whole Team:
 - a. Question for essential worker podcast: Ask them, can you explain your side for Covid and what happened to you?
 "Since Covid 19, how has your mental health been impacted? What things have you done to improve your mental health and what you would recommend to others? What have you noticed about other's mental health? How is your workload?" (Guideline is on mental health).
 - v. Mission for podcast: Mental Massage is a monthly podcast series by the Mukilteo Youth Council exploring mental health from unique angles. Ranging from essential workers' stories to the intersection of race and mental health during this time, we hope to give our community new ideas, thoughts, and tips.

 - i. Roles:

 - ii. Decided on a tentative date as well. (February because it is black history month and the project is focused on black injustice).
 - iii. Plan to reach out to Niko Battle and Alex (organized Mukilteo protest) by next meeting
 - iv. Do not include parents because children feel uncomfortable; parents can come in at the end to ask any questions
 - v. Three pronged approach: History Lesson (origins of slavery to now), what we need to do as individuals (self-improvement), understanding policy actions and how we can positively influence them (lobby legislature to improve legislation), and reach out to other people for awareness

c. Mental health:

- i. Project: podcast and social media account if approved for clips of podcast and to advertise it
- ii. Overviewed possible topics and brainstormed for new topics, speakers and questions
- iii. Monthly podcast (no specific date)
- iv. Three teams within subcommittee: advertisement, outreach, podcast editing
