Meeting Summary

Meeting Objective: Advancing the cause of Public Safety in the Community.

1. MSO Hadland gave an overview of the Medical Services Officer program and the Community Paramedic program. He supports both through our ILA with Lynnwood Fire. Hadland outlined the types of unsheltered individuals present locally (under-employed, houseless by choice, transient, and some with mental health issues), their needs, and how the programs attempt to meet the needs. The committee discussed four options under the umbrella of growing existing programs. These include crisis intervention training for city and public safety safety, public education about the best ways to help, education with private property owners, and supporting a regional response team imbedded with the Police Department. Lynnwood is also discussing a regional center for unsheltered individuals. The Policy Analyst will attend the July meeting to assist with drafting recommendations for the committee to take to Council.
2. Chief Macklin provided an update on the police department.

3. The proposed ILA with Lynnwood and Fire District 1 was discussed. Three questions were posed by the committee members.
 - a. Finance should be the fiscal lead. [Ed. Note: this is set for discussion with Finance. The ILA isn't binding on duties, so that can be assigned to Finance without changing the multi-agency ILA.]
 - b. Question concerning the City's cost share calculation. [Ed. Note: Lynnwood confirmed this is accurate. It is calculated on 13.33% of the total cost share.]
 - c. The "Contractor" is not listed in the Definitions, but the partners are. [Ed. Note: Lynnwood is the grant recipient, so is by default the contractor in the agreement with the Federal Government.]
4. Chief Alexander provided an update on the fire department.

Next Meeting: July 7th, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. at the Police Department. Topics of discussion for that meeting will be an update on the repairs to the facility post windstorm, an overview of New World, discussion on the FD 1 ILA in preparation for Council discussion in August, and drafting recommendations for Council on unsheltered persons.
