Meeting Summary

Meeting Objective: Advancing the cause of Public Safety in the Community.

- 1. Discussed a draft ILA with Snohomish Health District. Deferred further action pending revenue to support the ILA.
- 2. Chief Kang provided an update on the Police Department. Requested support for a position change for the Police Commander to Assistant Chief to be consistent with the rank terminology used in the profession.
 - a. Committee recommended forwarding the title change for Council approval.
- 3. Discussed a draft Strategic Plan for the Fire Department. Committee members committed to reviewing and providing any comments to Chief Alexander
- 4. Chief Alexander provided an update on the Fire Department. Requested support for an application for six additional firefighter positions through the Federal Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant which matches 75% in the first two years and 35% in the third year, with no grant requirement to retain the staffing level.
 - a. Committee recommended the application be submitted. If the department is awarded a grant, grant acceptance will come before Council for approval.
- 5. Committee discussed an EMS Levy lid lift and potential uses for the funding. Committee was supportive of the concepts, although final expenditures would be discussed as part of the annual budget process.
 - a. Committee recommended further discussion on the lid lift go to the Finance Committee.

- 6. Committee discussed National Incident Management System (NIMS) training for Council members. Committee requested the current completion data for Council Members be included in the committee minutes. NIMS training is required for FEMA reimbursements.
- 7. Committee requested to meet with Fire District 1 representatives to discuss items of mutual interest (per a clause in the ILA) at their March meeting. An invitation has been extended to FD 1.
- 8. CM Champion reported that 91,000 people have been certified in the United States through the FAA to operate UASs since the program was initiated.
