Items included response to the large Lynnwood fire, calls for service between the two departments, progress on a regional fire authority, and phase II of the FD 1 capital facilities study. Committee members provided updates on City activities including waterfront development, the new ferry dock, EMS levy lid lift, and annexation discussions.
