#### **Old Business Items:**

• 2016 Spring/Summer New Programs-

Recreation Coordinator Ellsworth presented all the new programs that were implemented for Spring and Summer. Ellsworth reviewed that many of the ideas came from the completion of the Recreation Inventory, the Recreation Service Analysis and feedback from the Rosehill Board. Recommendations for new programs were made to the Board in December and staff implemented many of the new programs into the Spring/Summer guide. Some of the new programs include a hiking program, a park stewardship program, paddle boarding classes, cooking classes for kids, a drama program, positive parenting and babysitting classes. Also implemented were pocket sketching, senior pilates, senior safety and 911, coffee and sunset socials.

Marketing of Recreation Programs and Events-

Recreation Coordinator Ellsworth reported on all the new classes offered staff and the different marketing techniques to promote the classes. Some of the ideas that are being implemented from the Board suggestions:

- Produce flyers to hand out to the schools and businesses around town.
- > Develop a schedule of Facebook posting and keep it fresh.
- ➤ Connect with the Beacon to interview some of the instructors —Beacon will provide free stories on programs if the programs are free to the community
- > Connecting with Mom Groups and getting information to them on upcoming classes.

- > Developing flyers for youth and preschool programs that can be handed out at the Library's story time.
- Research what it would cost to put the recreation guides on the Ferry. If not the guide, maybe developing a rack card that could go in the kiosks on the ferry.
- ➤ Connecting with local churches to see if they would display the Recreation Guide.
- > Put a plastic holder on the Community Garden Kiosk to display flyers and Recreation Guides.
- Recreation Coordinator Ellsworth asked the Board for marketing ideas: to bring people to
  the Touch A Truck event. Board Member Almgren suggested creating a Passport book to be
  used at Touch A Truck. If you register for 2 classes you can be entered into a drawing for a
  prize. Staff will look into the possibility of implementing this or a version of this for the
  upcoming event.

#### **New Business Items:**

• Review of Rosehill Community Center Staffing Model

Recreation and Cultural Services Director Berner stated as part of the 2016 budget process a staff re-organization of the Recreations Department was presented to City Council. City Council approved the additional funds but asked staff.to present the proposal to the Rosehill Board for feedback. The Rosehill Board appointed a subcommittee to work with Director Berner on the staffing model review. Board Members Almgren, Crawford and Saul met and discussed this issue. The Sub-committee asked Berner to prepare information that would compare Rosehill staffing with other community centers staffing models and look at demographics to see if there are any projects that could be made about growth.

The Rosehill Board heard the report from Berner comparing staffing models and information on demographics. There was discussion and agreement on the reorganization.
