NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mukilteo Hearing Examiner will hold a Public Hearing on August 2, 2017 at 1:30 P.M. in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 11930 Cyrus Way, Mukilteo, Washington.

The purpose of the Hearing is: for consideration of a Conditional Use Permit for Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District's proposed project to replace the existing Lift Station 10 with a new 1,500 square foot lift station. The new lift station will serve approximately 838 acres in north Mukilteo, including downtown. Parking is provided on-site within the fenced area for maintenance vehicles to park while performing maintenance functions at the new lift station. The building will be approximately 17 feet tall and be constructed of CMU walls, with a concrete foundation and prefabricated truss roof with associated grading, landscaping, and street frontage improvements.
