NOTICE OF CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING MUKILTEO CITY COUNCIL

Shoreline Master Program Update and Title 17B Shoreline Management Regulations Code Amendment

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mukilteo City Council's October 7, 2019 Public Hearing was continued to **Monday**, **October 28, 2019** at 7:00pm in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 11930 Cyrus Way, Mukilteo, Washington.

The subject of the public hearing is an update to the Mukilteo Shoreline Master Program (SMP) in accordance with the State of Washington Shoreline Management Act, including amending Title 17B Shoreline Management Regulations in the Mukilteo Municipal Code. The City and WA State Department of Ecology are accepting comments on the periodic review of the City's SMP under RCW 90.58.080(4). The draft amendments to the SMP were prepared by the City to keep the document current with changes in state law and rules, to ensure it remains consistent with other City of Mukilteo plans and regulations, and to be responsive to changed circumstances, new information and improved data. All supporting documents are available at City Hall for public review.

This is an Open Record hearing. All members of the public are welcome to provide testimony either in person or in writing at the continued public hearing. If you are unable to attend the public hearing, the City encourages you to provide written comments. Written comments, which will be provided to the City Council, will be accepted at City Hall, located at 11930 Cyrus Way, until 4:30 p.m. the day of the October 28, 2019 public hearing.
