

Spring Clean-up is coming to Mukilteo on your regular trash pickup day! May 1 or May 3, 2017

Spring Clean-up takes place this year on your **regular trash pickup day** either Monday, May 1 or Wednesday, May 3.

The City sponsors this annual community service for regular residential customers within the city limits, in cooperation with Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. and Waste Management–North Sound.

Items for pickup must be bundled, boxed, or bagged and placed at curbside with your regular trash containers. Large quantities and large items must be placed at a public street where large trucks can easily pick the items up.

There is no limit to the number of bundles; however, each must be <u>light</u> enough for an average person to lift. Branches and limbs must be wrapped or bundled in lengths of no more than three (3) feet. Large tree rounds or entire trees are not allowed.

You may arrange for pickup of refrigerators and freezers by calling 425-263-8000, prior to the end of the day on Friday, April 28. Please remove doors from all appliances before placing at curbside. You do not need to call in other large items, just place them with your regular trash.

Please do not place for pickup:

Paints, solvents, pesticides, gasoline, cleaning materials, tires, rocks, concrete, construction debris, or sod, large tree rounds or entire trees.


