# 3<sup>rd</sup> STREET ROAD CLOSURE APRIL 20, 2022 – MAY 9, 2022

#### **Notice:**

Starting Wednesday, April 20, 2022 a short section of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street on the west side of SR525 will be closed while the Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District's (District) Contractor, Shoreline Construction, Inc. completes an underground boring to install a new water main underneath SR525. The road closure is expected to last until May 9, 2022. See map on the next page for the location of the road closure.

### **Background:**

This work is part of the District's 2022 Water System Improvements Project that began construction in mid-March and will replace approximately 2,800 lineal feet of 6-inch cast iron water main with 8-inch and 12-inch restraint joint ductile iron water main throughout the west side of Old Town Mukilteo.

As part of this project, the existing 6" water main that crosses under SR525 at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street will be replaced with a new 12" water main. This new connection is necessary for the District to continue to supply reliable, safe and clean water for both consumption and firefighting uses.

To minimize traffic disruptions and to expedite the work, the new water main in this area will be installed by boring (drilling) the new main under SR525. The contractor will dig bore pits on the west and east sides of SR525 in 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and install a 24" steel casing by boring(drilling) it from one pit to the other. Due to the location of other surrounding utilities, the bore pit on the west side of SR525 is unable to be excavated without a full road closure.

During the closure, driveway access to residences will be maintained and the contractor will post a detour route for vehicles.
