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MUKILTEO WATER AND WASTEWATER DISTRICT 2016 WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Notice:

Mukilteo Water & Wastewater District has awarded a contract to SRV Construction, Inc. to replace water and sewer mains in three areas of Mukilteo.

5th Street Water Main: This project replaces the old Cast Iron water mains starting at 6th Street/Cornelia, down to and along 5th Street, through the Dog Park, under the Railroad Tracks and then to the end of Scurlock Lane. The new mains will be constructed with restraint joint Ductile Iron.

LS #10 Force Main: This project replaces the remaining section of plastic sewer force main that runs along the Speedway (in the Ferry Holding Lane) with restraint joint Ductile Iron pipe. The new main will start near the Speedway/Clover Lane intersection, run up Clover Lane, along Washington Avenue, and back onto the Speedway connecting near 76th Street.

LS #2 Force Main: This project replaces the entire original 410 feet of Asbestos Cement sewer force main that runs up 84th Street from 53rd Street to near the Speedway with High Density Polyethylene and Ductile Iron.

Purpose:

These projects replace aging water and sewer lines that are near the end of their useful life and are subject to failure during seismic events. The new restraint joint water lines will better support fire hydrants, increase fire flow, and improve water quality.

Impacts:

5th Street area: The construction operations for this project should have minimal impact on traffic in the downtown area due to the ability to install the pipe along the edge of the roads. Cornelia, between 6th Street and 5th Street, will have a short term closure with associated detours. Traffic lanes may be temporarily closed with flaggers helping to direct traffic around the work zones. The largest impact will be the temporary loss of parking as the pipes are installed along the streets.

LS #10 Force Main area: Work hours along the Speedway will be limited to Mon.-Tue., 7:00 AM – 6:00 PM and Wed.-Fri., 7:00 AM – 2:00 PM. The work along Clover Lane and Washington Avenue will not commence until after June 15th, when school is out for summer. Traffic lanes may be temporarily closed with flaggers helping to direct traffic around the work zones. The largest impact will be the temporary loss of parking as the pipes are installed along the streets.

LS #2 Force Main area: The construction operations for this project should have minimal impact on traffic due to the limited size and duration of the project. Traffic lanes may be temporarily closed with flaggers helping to direct traffic around the work zones.
