# MUKILTEO WATER AND WASTEWATER DISTRICT SEWER LIFT STATION 5 FORCEMAIN UPGRADE PROJECT

#### Notice:

The Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District's (District) Contractor, Road Construction NW, Inc. is scheduled to begin construction on the Sewer Lift Station 5 Forcemain (FM) Upgrade Project on Monday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>. A new 6" High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) FM will be installed directly under the existing FM by directional bore from the Lift Station site located at the bottom of Smugglers Gulch to the upper portion of 63<sup>rd</sup> PL W. Construction will start at the Lift Station site. We anticipate the entire Construction Project to take up to two months to complete, weather dependent. Most of the construction activity will take place at the Lift Station location.

## Impacts:

The construction operations for this project will impact traffic in/along 63<sup>rd</sup> PL W where the FM exits the bore and will be tied into a new sewer manhole (see attached map). This will require a small section of 63<sup>rd</sup> PL W to be closed for a short period of time. Pedestrian access will be maintained, and no driveways will be blocked during this phase of construction. During the closure, some residents will need to drive a different route for ingress/egress. The new 6" FM will be fused together and temporarily laid alongside the roadways in areas without blocking driveway accesses. There will be a short period of time, when the FM is pulled back into the bore hole, where driveways on one side of 63<sup>rd</sup> PL W will be temporarily blocked. The Contractor will do the best they can to accommodate access during construction. Residents will continue to have uninterrupted water and sewer service during the project.
