NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING MUKILTEO CITY COUNCIL

Japanese Gulch Trailhead Property Rezone

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mukilteo City Council will hold a public hearing on **February 5, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.**, in the City Council Chambers, 11930 Cyrus Way. The public hearing will be held in person and virtually on Facebook and Zoom for those who wish to participate remotely.

The purpose of the public hearing is for the City Council to consider a rezone of a portion of the Japanese Gulch Park Property, specifically parcel number 00591100000507 located just north of the intersection of 76th St SW and 44th Ave W. The property is currently used as a parking lot and entrance to the Japanese Gulch Park. A rezone from Open Space (OS) to Public – SemiPublic is proposed. This site is being considered as a possible location for a senior center, although approval of the rezone is not an approval of any specific future use. All the existing uses are legally allowed in the proposed zone.
