## PROCLAMATION IN SUPPORT OF UKRAINE

March 1, 2022

*WHEREAS*, on February 23<sup>rd</sup>, Russian President Vladimir Putin sent troops to invade the sovereign nation of Ukraine; and

*WHEREAS*, it has been a week since this invasion, and the death toll is over 350 for civilians and climbing, including 14 children; and

*WHEREAS*, Mukilteo is home to many Ukrainian families, who have family in Ukraine fearing for their lives; and

*WHEREAS*, Mayor Marine has reached out to local leaders of Ukrainian churches in Mukilteo to ask how we can support their community during this time; and
