Response to Minnesota Events of May 25, 2020 June 1, 2020

WHEREAS, George Floyd, an unarmed African American man in downtown Minneapolis, was killed during his arrest; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mukilteo stands with all those affected, especially the black community and all communities of color; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mukilteo takes these matters seriously and works hard to provide adequate police training and promote a community of diversity and inclusion, as stated in the City's Vision Statement; and

WHEREAS, racism and or prejudice of any kind has no place in the City of Mukilteo; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mukilteo encourages Mukilteo residents to show constructive support, not engaging in violence or other crime; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mukilteo respects and honors all of our diverse residents and their right to equality, respect, and kindness, and asks residents to do the same for one another.
