VETERAN'S DAY November 11, 2020

WHEREAS, the people of this Nation are grateful to the veterans of our Armed Forces who have faithfully discharged the duties of citizenship and nobly served in times of national peril; and

WHEREAS, among the resources from which our country draws her strength we hold in high esteem the more than twenty-two million living veterans of our military, naval, and air services, and we treasure the freedom preserved for us by the sacrifice of many; and

WHEREAS, the Congress by an Act approved June 1, 1954 expanded the significance of November 11, theretofore declared a legal holiday and observed as Armistice Day, by designating it as Veteran's Day in honor of our veterans; and

WHEREAS, many Mukilteo residents and City employees are current and former members of the armed forces, and we greatly appreciate their service, sacrifice, and dedication to protecting our freedom.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Jennifer Gregerson Mayor of the City of Mukilteo, hereby call upon Mukilteo residents to observe Wednesday, November 11, 2020, as Veterans Day, in tribute to those who have thus added strength to the Nation and in renewed dedication to their work, building peace with honor among all nations.
