## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING MUKILTEO PLANNING COMMISSION Housing Action Plan (Resolution No. 2021-01)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Mukilteo Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, April 15, 2021, at 7:00 PM**. Due to COVID-19, this public hearing will be held virtually instead of in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 11930 Cyrus Way, Mukilteo, Washington. A Zoom link will be available on the City's Agendas webpage approximately five (5) days in advance of the meeting. **The purpose of the public hearing** is for the Planning Commission to consider a resolution to adopt a Housing Action Plan (HAP). The purpose of the HAP is to create a prioritized set of strategies to address Mukilteo's current and future housing needs. The HAP is based on an analysis of existing housing conditions and needs, an evaluation of existing policies and development regulations, and public outreach efforts. All supporting documents are available on the City's website for review.

This is an Open Record hearing. All members of the public are welcome to provide testimony either verbally at the public hearing or in writing. Verbal comments are limited to five (5) minutes. If you wish to send written comments, please email them to [lbalsky@mukilteowa.gov](mailto:lbalsky@mukilteowa.gov) by **4:30 PM on April 15, 2021**. All written comments will be provided to the Planning Commission.

Planning Commission will make a formal recommendation to City Council. City Council will decide whether to adopt the HAP by resolution after a public hearing in late Spring 2021. Separate notice will be provided.
