Approved Revised Shoreline Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 2021-NW-2279**

Dear Marsha Tolon:

On July 6, 2021, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received notice that the City of Mukilteo approved your request to revise shoreline Conditional Use Permit (CUP) #2014-NW-623) to retain approximately 390 square feet of existing over-water trestle supported by four 12-inch timber piles at the former Mukilteo ferry terminal to maintain an existing emergency egress utilized by an adjacent overwater building. The original CUP approved by Ecology on May 19, 2014, proposed to remove the trestle along with the remainder of the former ferry terminal. This site is located in the Urban Waterfront environment designation on the shore of Possession Sound.

By law, local governments must first review revised CUPs for compliance with:

- The Shoreline Management Act (Chapter 90.58 RCW).
- The Revision criteria in WAC 173-27-100
- The Local Shoreline Master Program.

After reviewing revised Shoreline CUPs for compliance, Ecology must decide whether to approve, approve with conditions, or disapprove the revision.

**Our Decision:**

Ecology approves your revised CUP provided your project complies with the conditions required by the City of Mukilteo. **Please note, however, that other federal, state, and local permits may be required in addition to this shoreline permit.**

**What Happens Next?**

At your own risk, you may begin your revised project immediately, provided you have all other required permits. However, a 21-day appeal period will begin on the date of this letter, during which anyone may appeal the CUP revision to the State Shorelines Hearings Board. The Shorelines Hearings Board could deny or modify your CUP revision. The Shorelines Hearings


