Wear a face covering and keep 6 feet apart from others in public spaces.

Wash hands before and after wearing a mask



Fit coverings snugly but comfortably against the side of the face



Use the ties or loops to put your mask on and off



Face coverings should have multiple layers



Avoid touching the front of the face covering, especially when you take it off



Wash and dry your cloth mask daily



Children 5 and over must wear a face covering

This [Order from the State Secretary of Health](#) requires Washingtonians, with some exceptions, to wear face coverings in public spaces (indoors in all situations, and outdoors when proper physical distancing can't be maintained). **People are individually responsible to comply with this order.**

The order is not intended to penalize people, but to encourage each of us to wear a face covering, protect one another and help keep Washington on the path to reopening.

The Governor's proclamation requiring masks inside of businesses is enforced by those businesses, with help from local law enforcement as needed. The Department of Labor & Industries could also cite a business that intentionally does not comply with the order.

Q: How will the City of Mukilteo support the wearing of facial coverings by all?

A: City employees will educate the public and businesses on the mask order, including directing the public to the resources below.

Workplace requirements are enforced by the Department of Labor & Industries.

Q: What should an individual do if they see someone not wearing a mask?

A: Nothing. Some people have conditions or circumstances that would make wearing a cloth face covering difficult or dangerous. **Just wear your mask and stay six feet away.**
