NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING MUKILTEO CITY COUNCIL

Permanent Flood Hazard Controls Code Amendment (Ordinance No. 1443)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mukilteo City Council will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, October 19, 2020, at 7:00 PM**. Due to COVID-19, this public hearing may be held virtually instead of in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 11930 Cyrus Way, Mukilteo, Washington. A Zoom link will be available on the City's Agenda webpage approximately five (5) days in advance of the meeting. The purpose of the public hearing is for the City Council to consider an ordinance to adopt *permanent* flood hazard regulations prepared in accordance with the Flood Disaster Protection Act of 1973, the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, Washington State Floodplain Management Regulations (Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Chapter 86.16), and RCW 35A.63.220.

The *permanent* regulations include minor clarifications to the *interim* regulations adopted under Ordinance No. 1440. The *interim* regulations repealed and replaced Chapter 15.12 of the Mukilteo Municipal Code (MMC) to keep current with the updated Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Risk Map (FIRM). The City was required to adopt updated regulations by June 19, 2020, and is required to adopt *permanent* regulations by December 19, 2020. All supporting documents are available on the City's website for review.

This is an Open Record hearing. All members of the public are welcome to provide testimony either virtually at the public hearing or in writing. Written comments, which will be provided to the City Council, will be accepted by email to ibalisky@mukilteowa.gov until 4:30 PM on October 19, 2020.
