

How to Apply for a Residential Parking Permit

1. Go to the Mukilteo Customer Portal: https://mukilteo.cmrpay.com

2. Click the "Sign Up Or Log In" button

- First time users, select the "Don't have an account? Sign up" option
- Otherwise, enter your email and password and push "Log In"

3. Select the permit you want from the drop down menu and click "Start New Permit" button Use the linked maps if you're not sure which zone you need

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- 4. Enter required information (name, license plate number, etc.)
- 5. Upload required documents and then press "Review" button
 - Proof of residency can be your driver's license or a utility bill with your Mukilteo address
 - Vehicle registration
- 6. If all the information looks correct, click "Add To Cart" button
- 7. Click "Check Out" button
- 8. Click the "Place Order" button
- 9. Allow 3-5 days for the City of Mukilteo to review your application.
- 10. Watch for approval email. Once you have that, your permit is Active and you're clear to park.



How to Apply for and Manage Guest Parking Permits

1. Go to the Mukilteo Customer Portal (https://mukilteo.cmrpay.com) and click "Log In"

You must already have an account and residential parking permit to apply for a guest permit.

- 2. Select the appropriate guest permit from the drop down menu and click "Start New Permit"
- 3. Select your active permit and then click "Start Applying"
- **4.** Confirm your location and enter your contact information. NOTE: Enter <u>your</u> information, not your guest's information.
- 5. Enter your requested number of guest permits and click "Next." and then "Add to Cart."

- 6. Click the following buttons on the next three screens:
 - "Add To Cart"
 - "Check Out"
 - "Place Order"
- 7. Allow 3-5 days for the City of Mukilteo to review your application.
- 8. Watch for approval email. Once you have that, your guest permit is Active.
- 9. When a guest needs a pass, log in to <u>https://mukilteo.cmrpay.com</u> and select "Manage Passes" option on the dashboard.



10. Select "Activate a Pass" option and then enter your guests' vehicle information. The pass will remain valid for 24 hours.
