1) Upcoming Council Agenda Items

- a) 61st Place Culvert Improvement – Consultant Contract Supplemental Agreement No. 6

Staff provided the Committee an overview of the above referenced Agenda Bills to be presented at the September 18, 2017 council meeting.

The Committee supported moving forward with the 61st Place Culvert Improvement Consultant Contract Supplemental Agreement No. 6.

The Committee supported the City Hall Parking Lot Repairs Contract Award and recommended that the Council award Schedules 1 and 2 and authorize a budget increase of \$27,000.

The Committee supported the award of the Decant Facility Project consultant contract in the amount of \$154,912.

2) WSDOT - 84th Street Overlay/Bike Lanes

Staff provided the Committee of an overview of WSDOT's 84th Street Overlay/Bike Lanes Project.

The Committee supported the project modifying the lane configurations, however requested that staff reach out to WSDOT to not convert to two eastbound lanes (uphill) unless there was traffic data to support it. The Committee's preference was to keep the lane configuration as-is at the westbound approach to SR 525. Staff reached out to WSDOT on September 13, 2017 after the Infrastructure Committee meeting and has yet to hear back.
