Notice of Approval

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

OMA Construction Inc. has applied for a noise variance to complete work outside the weekday-only construction hours conditioned in their March 11, 2022, Notice of Decision (NOD).

The purpose of the OMA Construction Noise Variance application is to get relief from Condition #16 in the project approval that restricted construction to between 7am and 9pm on weekdays.

The applicant is proposing to work Saturdays and this variance allows for that change. While working Saturdays will add construction noise impacts, it will also shorten the total construction duration for replacing the existing 54-foot-long culvert underneath the north end of 61st Place W at 88th Street SW (with associated streambed channel, storm drain, and road improvements). A shorter project duration will benefit the surrounding neighborhood by reducing the amount of time the street is closed and traffic routes are disrupted. Applicant proposes up to twelve (12) Saturdays of work, beginning no earlier than July 5, 2023, with expected completion by September 23, 2023.

PROJECT DECISION:

The project was reviewed for consistency with the standards and regulations of the City of Mukilteo and State of Washington Administrative Code and is hereby **APPROVED**.
