What Would I Be Doing?

Volunteer as an individual, as a family, or with a group. You and will be given a storm drain marking kit with everything you need to install the “No Dumping / Drains to Sound” markers. Instructions are provided.

How Much Can I Do?

As much as you want. You can place a specific number of storm drain markers, or spend a set amount of time. You choose!

Why Is This Important?

Markers are a reminder that storm drains connect directly to streams and Puget Sound.

Rainwater carries millions of pounds of pollutants from our neighborhoods into our streams and Puget Sound every year. The oils, soaps, pet waste, fertilizers and chemicals that leave our yards and streets go untreated! This can affect our ability to spend time in the water, harvest from local beaches and negatively impact the Orca, crab, salmon and other wildlife that live there.
