Meeting Summary

Meeting Objective: Advancing the cause of Public Safety in the Community.

1. Chief Kang provided an update on the Police Department. Advised the committee that the Department would be applying for a National Criminal History Improvement Program grant for funds to purchase a "Live Scan" digital fingerprinting system.
2. Committee members met with Fire District 1 commissioners to discuss items of mutual interest. Items included response to the large Lynnwood fire, calls for service between the two departments, progress on a regional fire authority, and phase II of the FD 1 capital facilities study. Committee members provided updates on City activities including waterfront development, the new ferry dock, EMS levy lid lift, and annexation discussions.

3. Chief Alexander provided an update on the Fire Department.
