Public Assistance Request

(MUKILTEO, WA) On May 19, 2018, at approximately 9:40 A.M., Mukilteo Police officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 9600 block of Harbour Place. Upon arrival officers discovered that a female was seriously assaulted during a domestic violence incident at the location. During the assault she was forced to ingest a controlled substance and became unconscious. The officers administered Narcan to counter the effects of the controlled substance which revived the female. She was then transported to a local hospital for treatment.

The Mukilteo Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident and is asking for help from the community. Detectives would like to talk to anyone who was at the scene during the incident particularly the woman seen in the photographs wearing a red dress. It is believed that she assisted the victim prior to police arrival and may be able to provide important information.
