Antennas will be installed pole top and an ancillary equipment cabinet will be installed based on the new Federal Way Wireless Code and in conjunction with the Public Works Department. Photo simulations are attached for typical installations based on pole type.

Verizon anticipates approximately 10-15 small cells to be built out in the City in the next few years. In an effort to partner with the City, Verizon would like to execute a Franchise Agreement first and then submit site specific locations to the Public Works Department.

If the proposed facilities and/or other equipment are proposed to be installed on poles, will the installation be on existing poles or does applicant anticipate the need to install new poles?

Verizon will utilize the existing infrastructure within the right of way. Should a new pole be required, Verizon will follow the procedures outlines in the City's Municipal Code.

Note - Applicants seeking to install new poles must follow the procedures outlined in the municipal code. Applicant should not presume that requests to install new poles will be approved.

Describe your site access policies.

Verizon will adhere to all City Construction Management policies and procedures.

Describe the transmission medium that will be used to provide telecommunications.

Small cells will use fiber and antenna's to transmit wireless service.

Indicate what licenses, certificates, and authorizations are required from the Federal Communications Commission, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and any other federal or state agency with jurisdiction over the proposed activities. Have all such licenses, certificates and authorizations been obtained?

Verizon is licensed with the FCC.

Small cells located in the public right of way will be used to provide wireless connectivity for the residents and businesses in the City of Federal Way.

The Internet Tax Freedom Act does not apply to wireless network services. Federal and local taxes are applied through alternative tax laws.


