

# Mukilteo Multimodal Project Construction alert

## What to expect during construction:

- The existing terminal will remain open and operational throughout construction
- Truck hauling hours will be limited to 7 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday.
- The water around the project area is restricted to divers and other recreational users during construction. Please obey all posted signs around the work zone.



## Ongoing impact pile driving

- Crews will begin using an impact hammer to install piles.
- Neighbors will hear a loud ‘pinging’ sound from each strike of the impact hammer.
- This work will be louder than construction activities to date. Noise levels will reach up to 90 decibels at the closest residences, or approximately the same level as a nearby lawnmower or motorcycle.
- This work is currently scheduled to take place between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Impact hammer work will last through December.
